Types of acute orthopaedic injuries treated at the After Hours Clinic

- Strains, sprains, and minor dislocations
- Breaks and closed fractures
- Sports injuries
- Torn ligaments or tendons
- Sudden joint injuries
- Work related injuries — *must bring employer's claim documentation*
